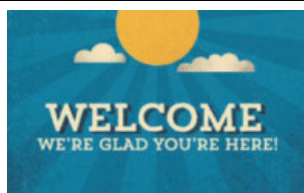

Life in the Spirit has been the topic in recent articles, and today I'd like to explain a liturgical celebration that has grown out of the Catholic Charismatic Renewal – "healing" Mass.

When we attend Mass and truly become involved during the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist, we often experience great inner peace and tranquility. We leave Mass feeling refreshed and nourished for the next week of life. By the end of the week, however, we have been so drained, that we need to return for the Lord to reinvigorate us.

Masses can be said for a variety of reasons: funerals, weddings, assignment of missionaries, prayer for peace, for those with disabilities, 50th wedding anniversaries among others. There is also a Mass that focuses directly on the health of mind, body and soul, and is referred to as a "healing" Mass. In many instances, the "healing" Mass is celebrated by a priest who has been "baptized in the Spirit" as was described in an earlier article.

As you may recall, we learned in catechism class that we received the Gifts of the Holy Spirit in Baptism, and those gifts were strengthened in Confirmation. The seven gifts are wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of God (i.e. respect for the Creator). The Church also recognizes, from lived experience, that some individuals who had attended "Life in the Spirit" seminars and had been "baptized in the Spirit" had received unexpected gifts reminiscent of those received by the apostles at Pentecost. Some of those unusual gifts were of healing, discernment of spirits, tongues, and interpretation of tongues.

The church has been cautious about recognizing those extraordinary gifts, and is very concerned to insure they are real gifts, and not false embellishments. Despite this very reasonable concern, the church acknowledges that these gifts are real. A few priests who were "baptized in the Spirit" were found to have received the gifts of healing or of tongues. Those priests then felt compelled to preside at "healing" Masses.

A further explanation about "healing Masses" and the "gift of tongues" will be provided next week. May God continue to bless you and yours.
