





All children 5-9 years of age can participate!



We have been exploring the Catholic Charismatic Renewal that had begun in 1967. Today concerns how the Holy Spirit is working in our time.

During our years as a parish, St. Philip's has periodically offered "Life in the Spirit" seminars, and for over 40 years supported a Charismatic Prayer Group. A fuller

understanding of the Holy Spirit's action in our lives should help us better continue our journey as intentional disciples of Jesus.

As you have heard me mention numerous times, I rely on the Spirit's inspiration for all my homilies. I take to heart Jesus' promise to his disciples not to worry about what they were to say when questioned about faith, since the Spirit would put appropriate words in their mouths.

But what does living "life in the Spirit" mean for you? Have you ever considered what charisms (gifts) you have received from the Spirit? What talents do you have? What are you really good at? What comes easy to you that is hard for others? All these are God's gifts, and I suspect that God intends us to use them not only to benefit ourselves, but also to help everyone around us.

None of us can do everything well. Major projects can only be completed through the actions of numerous people with many talents working together. That's easy to understand on a human level, but less understood on a spiritual plane. The Church is an assembly of the faithful; it does not exist solely for individual sanctification. Although our spiritual lives are extremely intimate (i.e. praying to God at all times, but especially in the quiet space where God hears in the quiet), they also have a communal element.

The success of St. Philip's as a parish depends on the quality of each parishioner's contribution. The word "contribution" can be considered tithing to the parish (our business manager is certainly eager for us to contribute generously), but our contributions are needed in many other parish activities. Our parish needs lectors, Extraordinary Eucharistic Ministers, altar servers, musicians and singers, ministers of hospitality at Mass and at fellowship functions, religious education teachers, coaches, Knights of Columbus, St. Vincent de Paul Society, membership in rosary and prayer groups, the Legion of Mary, etc. There are other ministries that we probably should have such as men's/women's clubs and youth groups.

As intentional disciples of Jesus, we are not meant to hide or bury our talents. Charisms are meant to be shared. The Holy Spirit has showered many graces upon us, but also expects us to reciprocate by utilizing



Baptism Information: Baptisms are celebrated on the second & fourth Sunday of each month. A pre-Baptism program must be attended by the parents. Please call the rectory to register for a program.

Marriage Information: Please call the rectory to make arrangements at least six months (a year is preferred) in advance of the wedding date. It is recommended you do not rent reception facilities until your wedding date is confirmed with the pastor. Your preferred wedding date may be unavailable, and we do not want you to lose your deposit with the reception venue.

Parish Registration: New families are welcome and are asked to register at the rectory. Also, previously registered parishioners are asked to notify us of any address changes.

Liturgical Ministries: We need men, women, and children to become Lectors, Communion Ministers, Ushers, and Altar Servers. Please contact Deacon Philip Heitz, OFS if you are interested.

Emergency Sick or Anointing Calls: Please notify us immediately of any serious illness in your family. If you have a hospitalized loved one who would like a visit, please call the rectory with contact information since the hospitals and hospices no longer notify parishes. Please do not wait until the last minute to have someone anointed. There are always accidents/emergencies, but sometimes there is less panic when the anointing can be done prior to someone passing.

We have low-gluten hosts available which make it possible for people who have celiac disease or allergies to wheat or gluten to be able to receive communion. If you have celiac disease or an allergy to wheat or gluten, please let us know before Mass so that arrangements can be made for you to be able to receive communion at Mass.


